Sunday Evenings - beginning March 19, at 6 pm, we will be starting a new series which will focus on discovering how the book of Exodus can help us prepare for perilous times of persecution, government restriction, and lack of essentials. The core of this study will be an exposition of the first 20 chapters of Exodus, led by Ron Stone. This study will be accompanied by discussion sessions exploring practical biblical ways to prepare for realistic potential challenges without fear, selfish hoarding, or putting misplaced trust in material sources of security.
